Directions:

Take 495 from Virginia and Maryland or 295 from DC to MD Rt 210 **South** (Indian Head Highway) which begins just east of the Wilson Bridge. From the beltway, follow 210 south for about 15 miles

Turn right on Md 227 West (Marshall Hall Rd) and follow for 2.3 miles to Fenwick Road.

Turn left on Fenwick Rd and follow for 1.4 miles.

Turn right on Westview Pl. Westview Pl is the driveway to Greenweigh. It is about a mile to the house. When the lane splits, stay left, through the brick gates. There will be signs marking the route. The physical address is 2025 Westview Pl, Bryans Road, MD.

Housel, known for his famous comments on “What is Auburn” talked about what Auburn means today to alumni, students, and friends. “Although each generation of Auburn men and women share similar experiences” Housel said, “Auburn is always changing and each generation will remember Auburn differently. Auburn is in our hearts.”

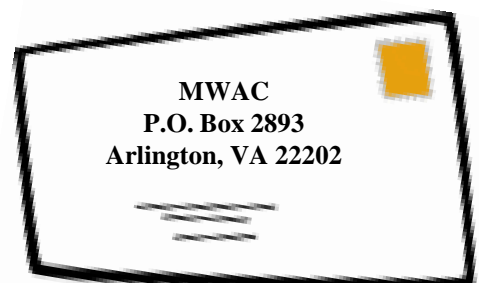


Representing the Auburn Alumni Association was Lori Ann Summers. Ms. Summers is the Assistant Vice President of Alumni Affairs at Auburn.
